NEW VOTER INFORMATION CARDS MAILED TO INDEPENDENT VOTERS

St. Lucie County, FL – The Supervisor of Elections office recently mailed **5,000** new voter information cards to Independent voters, indicating that their party affiliation has been changed from Independent Party of Florida (INT) to No Party Affiliation (NPA). The change comes after counties were notified by the Florida Division of Elections, that Independent Party of Florida was cancelled for failure to comply with Sec 103.095(5), Fla. Stat., effective November 29, 2016. This effects state-wide 258,914 registered voters.

If a voter would like to choose another party, they must complete and sign the form enclosed with the voter information card and return it to the Supervisor of Elections office within 30 days to receive their new voter information card, otherwise they will remain registered as NPA.

”I believe that these voters intended to be registered as independent of any political party. This change to No Party Affiliation (NPA) will accomplish that for them” stated Gertrude Walker, Supervisor of Elections.
