Voters Removed from Active Voter Files

St. Lucie County, FL- Gertrude Walker, St. Lucie County Supervisor of Elections is encouraging voters to keep their records current, because so many voters were removed due to returned undeliverable mail. If you have moved and have not notified the Supervisor of Elections, you could be one of them.

As required by law, 5,315 registered voter records have been placed on inactive status (this includes only those voters for whom an address confirmation final notice was undeliverable or who did not respond to their notice within 30 days.) Another 7,545 inactive registered voters have been removed from the statewide voter registration system (these are registered voters who were placed on the inactive list and who for two general election cycles thereafter did not vote or did not request an absentee ballot, nor updated their registration record.)

The Florida Department of State/Division of Elections requires Supervisors of Elections to provide a Certification of Address List Maintenance Activities, July 31st and December 31st of each year (s.98.065(4)(c), F.S.
