CANVASSING BOARD AND L&A SCHEDULE

PRIMARY ELECTION, AUGUST 18, 2020

The following is the *tentative* schedule of meetings for the 2020 Primary Election. All meetings will be held at the Supervisor of Elections Election Center, 4132 Okeechobee Road, Fort Pierce.

***Thursday, July 30, 2020 – 8:00 am** – Convene for Logic and Accuracy Pre-Test of voting equipment. (101.5612, F.S.) – No more than 10 days prior to beginning of early voting)

***Friday, July 31, 2020 – 7:00 am** – Public Inspection of absentee ballots, canvass Absentee Ballots; if second L&A *is not required*,

***Monday, August 3, 2020 – 7:00 am** – Cancelled

***Saturday, August 8, 2020 – 7:00 am** – Public Inspection of absentee ballots first 15 minutes, canvass Absentee Ballots.

***Tuesday, August 11, 2020 – 7:00 am** - Public Inspection of absentee ballots first 15 minutes, canvass Absentee Ballots.

***Friday, August 14, 2020 – 8:00 am** – Public Inspection of absentee ballots first 15 minutes, canvass Absentee Ballots.

***Tuesday, August 17, 2020 – 7:00 am** - Public Inspection of absentee ballots first 15 minutes, canvass Absentee Ballots.

***Tuesday, August 18, 2020 – 1:00 pm** – Reconvene to canvass Absentee Ballots, Provisional Ballots and precinct election returns, (101.048 F.S.)

***Thursday, August 20, 2020 – 3:00 pm** – Reconvene to canvass Provisional Ballots and Signature Cure, (No later than 5 pm on the 2nd day after any election 101.048 F.S).

- **Friday, August 21, 2020 – Noon** – Deadline to submit 1st Unofficial Results to DOS - include the canvass of all ballots including provisional. (No later than noon of the 3rd day after a Primary Election 102.141 F.S.)
- **Tuesday, August 25, 2020 – Noon** - Deadline to submit Official Results, file copy of voting system, and submit reports on the conduct of the Primary Election to the Department of State and begin publicly noticed audit of the voting system for the Primary Election unless manual recount undertaken. §102.112, 102.141, 102.591 F.S. – 5 p.m. on the 7th day following any primary election.

***Tuesday, September 1, 2020 – 10:00 am** - Reconvene to complete the voting system audit and for the results to be made public unless manual recount undertaken pursuant to §102.166, F.S. §101.591, F.S.; Rule 1S-5.026, F.A.C. – No later than 11:59 p.m. on the 7th day following certification of the election by the county canvassing board.

***Meeting dates subject to change based on canvassing board member's availability.**

Tentative Schedule in the Event of a Machine or Manual Recount

***Saturday, August 22, 2020 – 7:00 am** – Reconvene for Logic and Accuracy Pre-Test of Voting equipment 101.5612, FS, and conduct a Machine Recount if ordered, 102.141(7), FS, (the board responsible for certifying the results of the vote shall order a machine recount.)

***Saturday, August 22, 2020** – Reconvene for Manual Recount 102.166, F.S.) Immediately following the machine recount.

Sunday, August 23, 2020 – 3:00 pm – Deadline to submit 2nd Unofficial Results to DOS, if there is a recount (include the canvass of all ballots including provisional (No later than 3 pm of the 5th day after a Primary Election (102.141 F.S.)

Tuesday, August 25, 2020 – 3:00 pm – Deadline to submit Official Results to DOS (by 5 pm on the 7th day following a primary (102.112 F.S., the Report on Conduct of Election (102.141(9) F.S., and select precincts for automated audit.
