

NOTICE OF SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

CITY OF FORT PIERCE, FLORIDA

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Fort Pierce will hold a special election on Tuesday, December 7th, 2021, for the following office:

City Commissioner, District 1, Seat 5: for the remaining term to November 2022

A run-off election will be held February 8, 2022 if no candidate in a race receives fifty percent plus 1 of the votes cast in the election held on December 7, 2021.

Candidates must be qualified electors and residents of the City of Fort Pierce and the district for at least two years prior to the election.

The qualifying period is to be held from noon September 13, 2021 to noon September 17, 2021 at the City Clerk's office located at 100 N. US Highway 1 Fort Pierce, FL 34947. Linda Cox is the City Clerk and can be reached at 772-467-3065. In accordance with F.S. 99.061(8) the City Clerk will accept and hold qualifying papers submitted not earlier than 14 days prior to the beginning of the qualifying period, to be processed and filed during the qualifying period along with the applicable qualifying fees or proof of nomination by petition method. Campaign expense report due dates are as follows: 9/10/21, 9/24/21, 10/8/21, 10/22/21, 11/5/21, 11/12/21, 11/19/21, 11/26/21, 12/3/21, 12/10/21, 12/24/21, 12/31/21, 1/7/22, 1/14/22, 1/21/22, 1/28/22, 2/4/22. With termination reports due as applicable on, 12/16/21, 3/7/22, and 5/9/22.

Registration books for this election will close on November 8, 2021. Voting will be held for residents of District 1 in the City of Fort Pierce at the precincts listed below.
