Date Set for the City of Port St. Lucie Special Election Run-off and
City of Fort Pierce Special Election
December 7, 2021

As a result of the September 21, 2021 Special Election for the City of Port St. Lucie, a Run-Off Election for City Council District 3 will be held on December 7, 2021 between the top two candidates receiving the highest votes. Also appearing on Port St. Lucie ballots will be a question regarding an **Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption** for the City of Port St. Lucie. In the City of Fort Pierce, due to the recent passing of City Commissioner Rufus Alexander, a Special Election will also be held on December 7, 2021 for voters living within District 1 of the city. Should no candidate receive 50% plus 1 vote in the Fort Pierce City Commission, District 1 race a Run-Off Election will be held on February 8, 2022.

Vote By Mail: Due to standing requests, over 37,000 voters will begin receiving Vote by Mail ballots after November 4, 2021. Voters may contact the Supervisor of Elections Office to request a Vote By Mail ballot through the 2022 election cycle. Voters that wish to return their ballot via drop box will be able to do so at Supervisor of Elections Offices during business hours due to legislative changes from Senate Bill 90.
